Résumé: (traduction alternative) Short rappel canyon that flows into a great canyon (Rio Pelago). \nCan be combined with Mariana for a joint tour (see description Mariana).		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) Leave the A-11 from Florence to Viareggio - Pisa at the Lucca exit and head north on the SS12 along the Serchio River. At Chifenti the SS12 continues on the right towards Passo del Abetone. But we turn left here on the SP445 in the direction of Castelnuovo di Garfagnana. After about 3 km turn right towards Tereglio - Alpe Tre Potenze. In Tereglio continue in the direction of Passo del Giovo. After about 6 - 7 km turn right in the direction of Orrido di Botri to the large tourist parking lot at the exit of the canyon at 640 m above sea level in Ponte a Gaio. Park the car here (parking lot "P1" - see also "Approach" in photo gallery).\ If you want to enter from Ref. Casentino - see "Access" below - continue with a second vehicle for about 9.4 km on the road to Passo del Giovo. Passing by the Rifugio Casentino at 1250 m above sea level, park the car on the right in a square where a clearly visible path begins to descend slightly ("P2").		
Approche: (traduction alternative) Either via Rifugio Casentini as in the upper access to the Mariana (E4) and then on the "Gea 14" (Grande Escursione Appenninica) across the Mariana down to the Colle de la Prada to enter shortly thereafter directly into the Ribellino ("E2"). \n\nEasier - also because feasible without transposition - from the parking lot at Ponte Gaio "P1" (660m a.s.l.) we can follow the "Gea 11" in an easterly direction uphill on the ridge to about 1340m a.s.l., where the path branches. We now keep left on "Gea 12" until "Gea 14" branches off to the left of "Gea 12". We take the "Gea 14", which then crosses a left tributary of the Ribellino (entry "E1"). Follow this tributary until it joins the Ribellino. We come here further down only in the Ribellino, but in time for the interesting part.\nOf course, you can continue up the path - passing an alp - to enter directly into the Ribellino ("E2").		
Tour: (traduction alternative) 5 or 4 (with side ascent) rappel in Ribellino, then river walk (with downclimb) in Orrido di Botri.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Right out onto the bridge and to the car.
