Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Small catchment area, as soon as the canyon has no more avalanche snow, it should be doable.		
Accès: (traduction alternative) Park in Stechelberg. The ticket can be redeemed at the restaurant for a meal or a drink.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) From there by bike to Trachsellaenen, and then it's 1000m uphill on foot. For a long time the route heads towards Rottal Hütte, but after the Bärenflue you turn left to the start of the .		
Tour: (traduction alternative) You start at the right tributary, then switch to the left at the hiking trail. At the top, some of the rappels are nicely polished, the further down it goes, the more bouldery it becomes.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) At the confluence with the Rottalbach, cross the field to get back to the bridge at Trachsellaenen.
