Résumé: (traduction alternative) Short beautiful lime canyon; sites renewed in 2015; short steep access; well combinable with Rio Pliz or Rio Malimberg. Adventurous access to the upper part.		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) From Chiusaforte you drive into the Raccolana valley. Approx. 1,2Km after the bridge in Raccolana there is a big gravel parking place on the right side and shortly after on the left side the power plant area with parking possibilities (a bit further up, directly at the exit there is only space for 1 car).		
Approche: (traduction alternative) From the parking lot, follow the road further up to the streambed with the small concrete house. Here you can judge the amount of water. Further you follow the very steep and inconspicuous path (trail) on the orographic left side, through the forest. After about 20min and some Hm one stands directly in the brook. Entry at 600m). If you want to try the upper part right uphill. At a small game feeding area cross left into the valley of the Rio Rivis (exposed). You reach the valley floor by 2xAbseils (1 Abseilsstelle is a narrow gap) - See Links + Video		
Tour: (traduction alternative) The Rivis is a worthwhile open, not al too difficult lime canyon that was newly established in 2015. Alternatively to the belay stations, some steps can be rappelled outside the water flow of tree loops. The canyon is a good alternative when other canyons have too much water or simply as a half-day tour. Right at the beginning there is a narrow passage with a clamping block under which you rappel. After that, several abseils follow each other shortly. At the highest point of about 40m, the belaystation is on the right side. Furthermore, 2 abseils (25 and 15m) follow before you descend over the last rock steps. In the shallow streambed you will soon reach the concrete house and the bridge (440m).		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Get off just to the left before the bridge. Depending on the parking possibility go back to the power station cottage or gravel parking place.
