Résumé: (traduction alternative) Vertical canyon, mostly dry. Interesting in spring after rain		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) Between Osogna and Biasca, turn off to the large catch basin. At the very exit there is space for a good 5-6 cars (see coordinates)		
Approche: (traduction alternative) The ascent is orthogr. right. Especially the first 5 minutes are practically pathless; just steeply uphill (keep left) Once you have found the path, follow it uphill for a good 60 minutes; partly exposed, secured with steel ropes and often with several possibilities (make it shorter or longer, ...) you go up; at about 800 hm a path points right to the creek entry at about 750 hm The path is roughly marked on the Swiss topographic view, on OSM etc. nothing is currently visible.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) First some shorter rappels (max. 35m). Then you reach the high edge; this is divided into approx. 55m / 50m / 15m / 35m. At the second higher abseil, after approx. 20m on the right at the water course, you reach the belay for the final C50 Thanks to Lars , Luci ,...etc for setting it up and making it "public"

Very nice vertical alternative tour if there is otherwise too much water. Swisstopo is highly recommended. At the beginning it is quite a search until you find the path, then it is super well marked. At 560m you have to leave the well-marked path before the wire insurance to gain altitude. The path you branched off onto to gain altitude is then immediately visible and marked again. The tour is very well set up. ATTENTION at the last large cascade or. Keep RIGHT in the direction of the main water flow, as described, otherwise you will miss the 50m stand. For all those who, like us, do not read the description thoroughly, there is now a sling with a major link ☐ near a tree in the wall, ortographic left. However, this is relatively difficult to reach and not recommended! So read the description ☐ (traduction alternative)
