Résumé: (traduction alternative) Almost pure rappel canyon. Very vertical and often a lot of wood in it.		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Relatively dry		
Accès: (traduction alternative) You can enter "Vorderkaserklamm" in the navigation system. Park at the bottom, check with the ticket office, they are very friendly, and if you ask for a final beer/snack, everyone will be happy.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) Follow the normal hiking trail in the gorge to the exit of the dark gorge. Where the canyon opens up, you can rappel from the orographic left using a single rappel, or otherwise climb over the iron and down the rock.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) After the entry, there are several abseils between 10 m and 40 m. There are generally very good belays and a few small jumps. However, a little caution is required due to gravel (or chain position) and wood piles.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) At the exit of the gorge you come to an open stream. There you can see the restaurant and the parking lot again.
