<b>Résumé:</b> (traduction alternative) Rappel canyon dry, beautiful views to the neighboring island of Gran Canaria, 2 separately accessible parts.		
<b>Hydrologie:</b>		
<b>Accès:</b> (traduction alternative) From the airport in the south of the island on the TF-1 to NNO. After 39.3 km (from the entrance to the highway) leave the TF-1 at exit 20 at El Socorro and take the TF-281 in a westerly direction up to Hidalgo to the TF-28. 175 m on this road turn left in the direction of the center of Hidalgo, then turn right again on the TF-245 up to Arafo. In the center of the village, turn left in front of the administration building and the church. At the next traffic circle turn right into Calle Jose Antonio. Follow this street straight on upwards - later it is called Calle La Libertad - until after 1.2 km (from the traffic circle) the Camino Morra del Estanque turns off to the left. Here park the (lower) car in a suitable place. \n \nlf you have only 1 car available, the access begins here. \nlf you have 2 cars at your disposal, a conversion of 23 km is possible, cf: \nYou donâ€™t gain time, you lose time, but the access from the top is scenic. The problem is that the car parked at the top is prone to breakage (we unfortunately had to experience).		
<b>Approche:</b> (traduction alternative) Access from top to bottom: From the TF-24 we turn onto the dirt road in a southerly direction. It leads us through sparse pine forest down to the black cone Caldera de Pedro Gil./ Arafo/Montana de las Arenas. We continue downhill past it on the left. Where the dirt road crosses the stony streambed at the confluence of the Barrancos de Cosme and de las Saletas (1450 m a.s.l.) we can enter the barranco (here called Bco. de las Saletas). \n\nThe access from below we walk from the car down the cross road a few meters south and then follow the Camino Morra del Estanque uphill. Where the road begins to swing south at 835 meters above sea level, a dirt road goes to the right to homesteads on the edge of the canyon. We continue a few more meters to the left on the road and then turn onto the path up to the right. It mutates into the mountain path "T-2" (marking blue cross on purple background). At an altitude of about 950 m, a path branches off to the right. Down here would be the access to the lower part of the Bco or the (possibly emergency) exit from the upper. \nWe keep left and continue climbing. We come out of the forest, pass the Refugio de las Arenas, leave the track to the right about 200m after that and traverse in a left turn down into the canyon (about 1250m entry altitude, so much lower than the access from above). Of course, you can also continue coming from above next to the Bco. the slope down here to enter here at a lower point.		
<b>Tour:</b> (traduction alternative) See photos and video ! \nExit and access possibility at the relay in the 2nd high rappel at the tunnel window of the water pipe. \nInteresting the especially at the 1st high rappel clearly visible lava flows, each covered again by earth. \nAt the end somewhat "herbaceous".		

**Retour:** (traduction alternative)

Exit onto the crossing tarred road under the water drainage and right to the (lower) car.

Great descent to do in full with 2 cars and sunset on Teide on the return trip. We entered the canyon at 1450, exited 680. In the upper part a few natural anchors and spits (could be completed), lower part has been recently rebolted with extra 12mm steel anchors, on top of the glue-in bolts. We went through with machete + drill. Full descent takes 6-8hrs + car logistics.
